A wide range of recreational, educational and conservation activities are planned often in conjunction with other local conservation groups.

Membership is open to residents, sailors, fishermen, walkers, bird watchers, naturalists, artists, cyclists, holiday makers and anyone else interested in the care and well being of the Harbour.

### Objectives

=> To help maintain, repair and improve Langstone Harbour and its surrounding environment;

=> To protect and preserve the countryside and wildlife along the coast;

=> To advance the education of the public in relation to the harbour.

The friends are affiliated to the British Trust for Conservation Volunteers.



## Conserving The Harbour

We will keep you in touch with harbour issues and events by sending you information by e mail or Newsletters.

We will offer you the chance, and encourage you, to join in practical work around the harbour but you do not have to do this. Just by being a member you do help us as our membership numbers are relevant when we talk to local Government and other authorities.

### Practical Activities

These include :

- => Identifying things that need attention;
- => Litter clearance;
- => Wildlife surveys;
- => Improving paths, hedges and wildlife habitat.

All this is done in the company of like minded people and usually with the guidance of an expert. This way the tasks are fun and you learn work skills or about wildlife as you work.

Since the Friends started monthly Work-outs' have covered virtually every corner of the harbour. We have removed old fences, put in fences and steps, surfaced paths, planted hedges, placed nest boxes and done many oth-
